

# Notice of Race

## CANADIAN LASER & LASER RADIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Friday July 7 to Sunday July 9, 2006

**Gimli Yacht Club**  
**Gimli, Manitoba, Canada**

### 1. Organizing Authority

The event is being organized by the Manitoba Sailing Association in conjunction with the Gimli Yacht Club.

### 2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, the rules of the International Laser Class Association, except those which are altered by the Notice of Race, and by the Sailing Instructions. This event is sanctioned by the International Laser Class Association, North American Region and the Manitoba Sailing Association.

### 3. Advertising

Advertising will be unrestricted to Category C.

### 4. Eligibility

Laser and Laser Radial competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their National Laser Class Association may enter. Proof of ILCA-NA membership and of membership in a club which is currently a member in good standing of the CYA will be required.

### 5. Measurement

Sail and blade measurement will be required at this regatta. Ensure that sail numbers are applied in accordance with ILCA class rules. Sails and blades may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta.

### 6. Race Schedule

- 6.1 There are 12 races scheduled for each class.
- 6.2 The Friday July 7th warning signal for the first race of the competition will be 1100 hr. The warning signal for the first race of each subsequent day will be 1000 hr.
- 6.3 The schedule of races will be contained in the Sailing Instructions. No race will be started after 1400 on Sunday July 9th.
- 6.4 A Competitor's meeting will be held at 0900 hrs on Friday July 7th at the Yacht Club deck.

## 7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available during on-site registration.

## 8. Courses

The race course will be similar to standard ILCA-NA courses as described in the ILCA-NA Regatta Guidelines.

## 9. Scoring

- 9.1 The low point scoring system, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.
- 9.2 One race shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 If 5 or less races are completed, each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.
- 9.4 If 6 races or more are sailed, each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.5 When 11 or more races are completed, each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores excluding her worst 2 scores.

## 10. Safety

- 10.1 All competitors in dinghy fleets shall wear a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) at all times while racing.
- 10.2 All coach boats must carry and monitor a VHF radio while on the water, and will respond to requests for assistance from the Race Committee.

## 11. Registration

- 11.1 A completed registration form along with the entry fee of \$90 per boat if received by June 15, 2006 and \$100 thereafter. All entries shall be received by 1000 on Friday July 7.
- 11.2 Payment can be in cash or by cheque made out to "Manitoba Sailing Association". Registration fees include a T-shirt and dinner on Saturday.
