1. INVITATION:

CORK/Sail Kingston invites sailors in the **Laser, Laser Radial (Men and Women), 49er, RS:X, Windsurfer, Bic 293 and 29erXX** classes to come and sail in the **CORK OCR Regatta** in Kingston, Ontario, home of **CORK Sail Week®**.

- **Laser and Laser Radial Women's Class - ISAF Grade One and NA Grand Prix ranking event**
- **49er - Canadian Championship.** A medal race is scheduled for this class only on the afternoon of the final day. Addendum Q will not apply.
- **29erXX class - North American Championship**
- **RS:X & Windsurfer classes - Canadian Championship** (One day of slalom racing may be included.) For windsurfers other than RS:X this is a 3 day event - Sat, Sun & Mon.

2. SITE:

The regatta will be sailed from Portsmouth Olympic Harbour (POH), site of the 1976 Olympic Sailing events and the 2007 Volvo Youth Sailing ISAF World Championship. Racing will take place on the fresh waters of Kingston Harbour.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

The Regatta is open to members of the invited classes who have met all class membership and measurement requirements. (For the 29erXX and 49er classes both skipper and crew **MUST** be members of the Class Association.) Participants must have completed registration and paid all event fees before beginning official competition.

4. MEASUREMENT:

Competitors are responsible to ensure their boat and equipment complies with applicable class rules. Measurement checks may be conducted as per class requirements and competitors must be prepared to present their measurement certificate if requested.

5. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. In the event of conflict in any translation, the English version will prevail.

5.1 The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association to rule 68 and all the prescriptions to Appendix F Will apply. They can be found on the CYA website <http://www.sailing.ca> . They will be stated in full in the Sailing Instructions.

5.2 RRS Appendix P will apply.

5.3 For the ISAF grade 1 events, (Laser and Radial) decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

5.4 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

6. ENTRY & FEES: (Credit cards, Debit Cards, Money Orders, Bank Drafts or cash)

If the completed entry form and entry fee is received at the CORK/Sail Kingston office, on or before July 31, 2010:

The single handed Early Bird Entry Fee is	CDN \$190.00 + 13% HST
For windsurfers 3 day event the Early Bird fee	CDN \$130.00 + 13% HST
The double handed Early Bird Entry Fee is:	CDN \$285.00 + 13% HST

After July 31, 2010:

The Single handed Entry Fee is \$240.00 + 13% HST.

For the Windsurfers – 3 day event \$170.00 + 13% HST.

The Double handed Entry fee is \$355.00 + 13% HST.

Entry fees cover racing, two light dinners (for the 5 day events), a regatta souvenir and a per diem fee to the City of Kingston for use of facilities.

8. QUALIFYING SERIES: - LASER, LASER RADIAL

If, by the end of registration on Friday, August 20, any of the above classes has over 80 registrants, there will be a qualifying series for that class.

9. COACHES & COACH BOATS:

Coaches must register. On line registration is available at www.cork.org Coaches will be issued a numbered flag which they must display while in the racing area and are expected to monitor a CORK safety channel on their VHF radios, be available to assist in an emergency and attend the coaches meeting each morning. There is no coach fee but a \$20.00 deposit for the flag is required.

10. PRIZES & AWARDS:

In consultation with the class associations, CORK/Sail Kingston provides a variety of awards and keeps an honour roll of Star Athletes, based on top 5% results. For each One-Design fleet with over 6 entries, CORK/Sail Kingston medals will be awarded to the top three finishers. Additional prizes will depend upon the number of competitors in the fleet. Some class associations may provide their own additional awards.
